

Definition:

A commonly agreed upon, but not statutory or tariff-based minimum fee standard for professionals in the independent performing arts when public funding is involved.

Fee guidelines for actors (2016): 1 250 CHF / rehearsal Week 500 CHF / one-time show 400 CHF / several shows at same venue 800 CHF / solo performance	€ 140 / rehearsal day € 715 / week € 3 100 / month € 310 / show (10 % of monthly fee)	€ 165 / rehearsal day € 830 / week € 3 600 / month € 360 / show (10 % of monthly fee)	€ 175 / rehearsal day (8h) € 205 / rehearsal day (8h) for prof. with more than 5 years experience € 350 for first two shows € 200 for each following show

Conclusions:

- Minimum fee recommendations need consistency and solidarity
- Funders have increased their budgets in regions with minimum fee recommendations
- Sunders have included minimum fee recommendations in their lists of funding requirements
- In AT more independent groups started to employ their artists
- Minimum guidelines spread to other regions as well as other professions
- Minimum fees are MINIMUM fees, they are not FAIR PAY!
